LIGHTHOUSE ARTCENTER INVITES YOU  
TO D'ART FOR ART

TEQUESTA, Fla. — (Oct. 20, 2011) — The Lighthouse ArtCenter has one thing to say this fall: “On your marks! Get set! D’Art!”

That’s right — D’Art, as in for Art.

The popular event is set for Nov. 12 at the Tequesta museum and art school.

During the event, guests mingle over cocktails, savor a dinner prepared by Little Moir’s Food Shack, then, at the sound of the whistle, dart — make that D’Art — around the museum choosing works of art to take home.

“This is one of the few fundraisers in which attendees can take home items worth more than the amount of the admission fee,” says Katie Deits, executive director of the Lighthouse ArtCenter.

Nationally known artists donate paintings, photographs, sculptures, ceramic works and jewelry for the event.

Children’s book author Cathy Helowicz is returning to chair the event and Kathy Greene, WJTW’s Gal on the Go, will serve as emcee.

“It’s really a great way for the community to come together to support this valuable institution,” says Ms. Helowicz, who also is a Lighthouse ArtCenter board member.

The Lighthouse ArtCenter, northern Palm Beach County’s oldest cultural institution, was founded in 1963. Since that time, hundreds of thousands of people have passed through the museum’s doors to see works by internationally known artists, and thousands of students have taken classes at the School of Art.

“And we have no doubt hundreds of people will come through the museum just to see the works for which people will D’Art,” Ms. Deits says. The artwork will be on display in the museum until the day of D’Art for Art.

D’Art for Art is 6-10 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 12, at the Lighthouse ArtCenter, Gallery Square North, 373 Tequesta Drive, Tequesta.
