Tequesta, Fla. (May 24, 2010) — Experience the tempting, the tantalizing and the delicious this summer during the Lighthouse Center for the Arts' *Multiple Sins* exhibition from June 10 through September 25. The artwork depicts some of the "sinful" things we love most in life, such as chocolate, liquor, cigars and art depicting the human form. The exhibition features both juried and invitational artists, including well-known Florida painter Carol Korpi-McKinley with her giant *Junk Food* paintings, and fine-arts photographer Barry Seidman, with his *Drinks* and *Smoke* series. Other talented Florida artists have been selected to exhibit their enticing artistic creations through a juried competition.

The summer exhibition fare is so exciting that two receptions are planned to welcome the hottest of the art center's seasons. *Multiple Sins* will open to adult audiences only on Thursday, June 10, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., as a champagne celebration toasting the featured artists, Seidman and Korpi-McKinley. *Multiple Sins* and another exhibition, *The Fairytale Project*, will open together to all audiences on the center's monthly 3rd Thursday event reception, Thursday, June 17, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. In addition to meeting the selected artists, guests will enjoy "stations of sin" where they can treat themselves to chocolate nibblers, wine and liquor tastings and fabulous food creations.

Also scheduled for the popular 3rd Thursday series in July is fine-arts photographer Barry Seidman, who will lecture on "The Art and Magic of Still Life Photography" on Thursday, July 15, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Seidman will speak about his work and its development, and will provide insight into his techniques. Seidman will also reveal "tricks of the trade," as he will show the audience how he uses illusion to create the still life photography he is famous for in his commercial and fine-art work. He will discuss pieces from his fine-art series in the *Multiple Sins* exhibition, *Drinks*, *Smoke* and others. All events are free to members of the Lighthouse Center for the Arts and \$5 for non-members. 3rd Thursday cultural events are presented by Meyer Law Firm with support from BB&T. 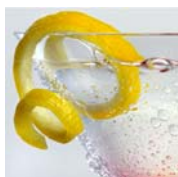

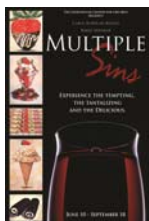
