ArtCenter Board of Directors gains strength in numbers, experience

Tequesta, Fla. (May 10, 2011) — Several important community leaders recently committed to serving on behalf of the local arts community: Andrea Cleveland, Cathy Helowicz, Malcolm MacKenzie and Alex Morton are the newest members of the Lighthouse ArtCenter Board of Directors. They offer expertise that will help support programming at the Museum and School of Art and guide further development of the not-for-profit as an important educational and cultural resource in Northern Palm Beach County.

“We’re so appreciative to have the involvement of this outstanding group of professionals,” said Lighthouse ArtCenter Executive Director Katie Deits, “especially in light of everything else they are doing for the community.”

Andrea Cleveland is a social worker and lifelong community activist. Since moving to Jupiter in 2006, she has worked with the Lighthouse ArtCenter Outreach Program to help develop art programming at El Sol Neighborhood Resource Center. She is also the director of El Sol’s ArtFest. She is married to Dr. John Cleveland, Chairman of the Department of Cancer Biology at Scripps Research Institute at the Florida Campus.

Cathy Helowicz is a writer and publisher of children’s books, and manages a computer consulting business. She currently serves on the board for the MdDs Balance Disorder Foundation, has participated in several Lighthouse ArtCenter committees, and is slotted for the second year as chair of the Lighthouse ArtCenter’s 2011 D’Art for Art benefit on November 12.

Malcolm MacKenzie, artist, photographer, world traveler and leading printing expert, is a native of Scotland and longtime New Englander. He and his wife, Dorothy, have resided for 17 years in BallenIsles, Palm Beach Gardens. MacKenzie has participated extensively in ArtCenter programming, having been featured in several art exhibitions, as well as volunteering his time as a docent for the *Gary Wiren Golf Collection Exhibition*. Recently MacKenzie was awarded Best of Show in the *Wildlife Photography Exhibition Competition* and was awarded an Honorable Mention in the *Member/Student Exhibition*.

Alex Morton worked in the advertising and marketing business for over 35 years in New York City and Detroit, where he promoted clients in various industries including retail, automotive, media and banking along with products such as household goods and appliances. Upon retiring from the agency business, he worked as a consultant for the Professional Golf Association and later became their Vice President of Marketing. Alex has served on a number of boards, and currently serves on the Board of Governors at the Jupiter Hills Country Club.

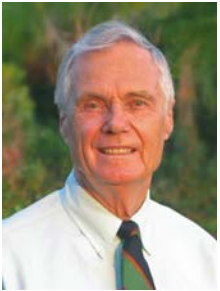
