### Drawing and Painting Alla Prima



#### Supplies

**Paints:** I recommend artists use a simple color palette, with a warm and cool of each of the Primary Colors

Lemon Yellow (cool)

Cadmium Yellow (warm)

Cadmium Red (warm)

Alizarin Crimson (cool)

Cobalt Blue (warm)

Ultramarine Blue (cool)

Titanium White

Paynes Gray

#### If using oils:

A Thinner, Turpenoid

Medium, Linseed Oil or Liquin

#### If using acrylic:

Just plain water will do

#### Canvas:

Pre-primed stretched canvas or canvas panel: size: 12x16 and or 16x20

#### Brushes:

Rounds #4, 6 & 8, Flats: #6, 8, 10 & 12 (1 of each)

#### Other:

1 Multimedia Pad, 14 x 17" or 18 x 24", paper in this pad should be rated a minimum of 100lb weight, which would be ok for use with water media paint, such as acrylic or watercolor

3 or 4 sticks of Willow Charcoal and a No. 4B Charcoal pencil for drawing

Plastic Palette or Disposable Palette Pad 12" x 16"

Plastic Mixing Tray that will hold your colors and provide and are for mixing colors

From home: container for water (yogurt containers or cans work great)
