

Creative Cloisonné: Enameling with Resin - with Amelia Cloisonné

MATERIALS & TOOLS NEEDED:

- Drawing materials: pencils and paper
- Sharpie marker
- Tweezers
- Course file - like a wax file or one for wood (to file resin)
- Dust Mask



10-15 feet silver cloisonné wire (Rio Grande inventory number: 102200)



Flat copper circles or ovals

pkg 10 2"x 2" 18g circles \$19.17 (RG: 682457)

pkg 10 46 x 36 mm 18g ovals \$16.78 (RG: 684760)



Slow cure (30 min) epoxy glue (or other two-part resin)



Assorted acrylic paint (you can mix your own colors
put a pack of colors keeps it easy)

Toothpicks or wooden craft picks for mixing and applying epoxy
Scrap paper for mixing epoxy (I like to use a pad of post-it notes)



Light-colored sandpaper (80 and 120 grit) and sanding stick
(you can use a paint stir-stick)



Assorted pliers (needle nose, half round, round nose, etc.)

Snips or wire cutters

(or a small pair or sharp scissors will work too to cut the cloisonné wire)
